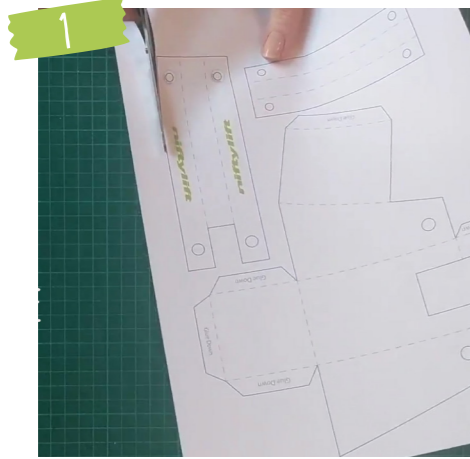


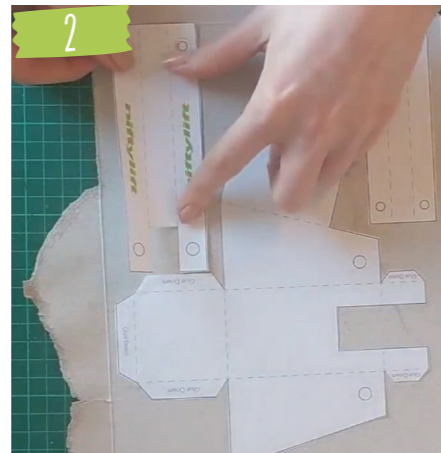

Please take care when using sharp objects during this activity. We recommend that children under 12 are supervised by an adult.

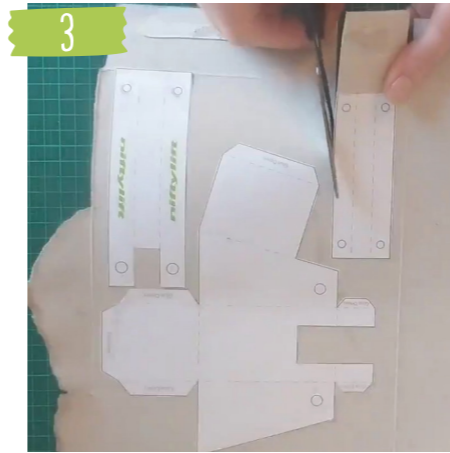
# HOW TO MAKE



Print out the 'Booms' template and cut out each of the pieces.



After cutting out each piece, use glue to stick them down onto cardboard.



These can then be cut out again so that each piece of the template is more durable and ridged.



Fold along all of the dotted lines of the template.



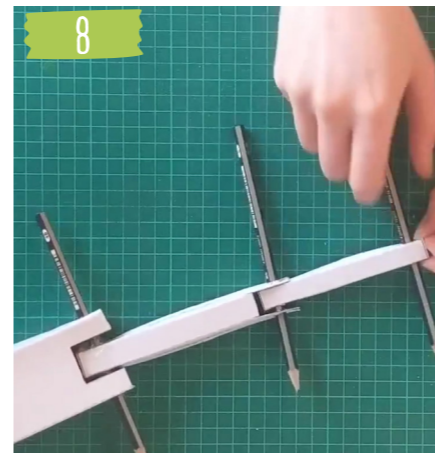
The holes in the template can be cut out by either using a hole punch or by pushing a pencil through the cardboard.



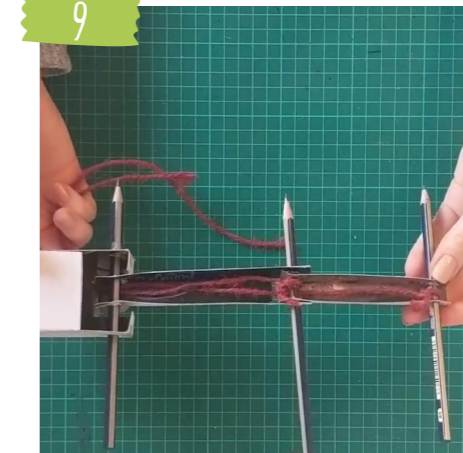
Glue down all of the tabs and assemble part 1. If the glue will not hold, you can use tape to secure the tabs in place.



Run a pencil through the holes of part 1 and 2 as shown to join them. Tape the pencil to part 2 so that it is unable to rotate.



Assemble part 2 and three together using another pencil. Then add the 3rd pencil to the end of part 3.



Tie 2 pieces of string to middle and right-hand pencil, making sure that they run underneath the other pencils and out the back.
